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Dear Parents/Guardians,

A lunch detention has been established for students whom are displaying behaviors that need to be avoided. We want to help all students make better choices and be successful. The lunch detention will take place during students' lunch time. Any student assigned a lunch detention will get his/her lunch and then report to the designated classroom. The classroom will be supervised by one of the fifth grade teachers.

Behaviors that should be avoided are:

- Not being prepared for class
- Disrupting class
- Inappropriate hallway, bathroom, or lunch time behavior
- Poor Attitude, refusing to do work or follow directions
- Being disrespectful to another student, teachers, teacher's aides or substitutes, etc.
- Damaging school property

The lunch detentions will be run on a "Three strikes you're out scenario." This means that a student will receive two lunch detentions as a warning. The third time the student displays the inappropriate behavior it would be a write up to the office.

Each time a lunch detention is given, a form will be sent home to notify the parents/guardians of the student's behavior and that he/she has been assigned to a lunch detention. The form will need to be signed and returned. In addition, we will submit an email to the principal to let him know when students are assigned to a lunch detention.

Lastly, while in lunch detention, students will be required to complete a form about the reason he/she is in lunch detention, why that behavior needs to be avoided, and how to change the unwanted behavior.
